## Instructions on how to access the Math Placement Tests

What you <u>MUST DO NOW</u>: Incoming Undergraduate students must complete their required Writing and Math Placement Process as soon as possible in order to sign up for Premiere or Transition DePaul, unless exempted from one or both of the exams. Placements are used as a guide for advisors to help students select the appropriate level coursework and should be completed to the best of your ability.

What you <u>MAY DO LATER</u> if required: Depending on your program of study, you may also be asked to take Chemistry and/or Modern Language Placement. While it is advantageous to take these exams before your attend Premiere or Transition DePaul or meet with your advisor, they are not required in order to sign up for your selected date. However:

- Students interested in enrolling in a Chemistry course must take the Chemistry Placement Exam at least one week prior to attending orientation, or meeting with an advisor.
- Students interested in enrolling in a Modern Language course are strongly
  encouraged to take the appropriate language placement exam to ensure that
  they enroll in the language course that best matches their ability and
  experience.

How to Access a Placement Test: Placement Tests, with the exception of Writing, are offered in Desire 2 Learn (D2L). To gain access to a particular Placement Test:

- Click on the desired test link button below.
- In the new window that opens, log into D2L using your Campus Connect user name and password.
- If the new window does not open, simply go to D2L directly (<u>https://d2l.depaul.edu</u>) and log in.

You will also receive an email with instructions for accessing your test.

Math Placement consists of five sections which require approximately 30 minutes each to complete. You must complete all five sections in one sitting, so please plan accordingly and allow 2.5 hours of uninterrupted time. All five sections must be completed before you can sign up for Orientation or meet with

your advisor.

Your advisor will use the results of your Math Placement Test to determine which math course you are prepared to take. It is important that you complete the placement test in a setting that allows you to focus.

#### Step 2
