CONDITIONAL ADMISSION

DePaul offers conditional admission in selected disciplines to qualified graduate applicants who have been educated in a language other than English and whose academic record qualifies them for admission, but whose level of English proficiency is lower than admission requirements or who have not taken any English proficiency exams.

Students who accept conditional admission must study at DePaul's English Language Academy (ELA) until they demonstrate English proficiency as required by the admitting unit.

ELA is a full-time, intensive English program focused on the language skills used in university degree programs. ELA courses are offered at five proficiency levels and taught by expert instructors. For details visit **ela.depaul.edu**.
