HEALTH INSURANCE

DePaul University requires that all F-1 students have health insurance, and we partner with <u>ISO</u> Student Health Insurance to offer affordable health insurance coverage to all international students.

IMMUNIZATION RECORDS

DePaul requires that every student submit proof that they have been immunized for specific diseases. For more information on required immunizations and the submittal process, go here: Immunization Requirements.

- We strongly recommend that all international students get immunizations in their home country prior to arriving in the U.S. ISO insurance does not cover immunization costs, which can be expensive for you in the U.S.
- We also recommend that you bring a copy of your records with you as backup in case you need to re-submit for any reason.
