I learned late this afternoon that someone hacked into various DePaul printers today, resulting in a white supremacist, anti-Semitic flyer appearing simultaneously in numerous output trays across our campus. We are currently investigating the breach as well as the source and origin of this despicable act, which certainly is not reflective of DePaul's values nor of our campus culture where ALL are welcome. The source was not a DePaul account, but from outside the university.

We do not know the extent of this hacking, and so I would ask your assistance in destroying any of these flyers that appear in your printers. In addition, the university's remote printing feature will be turned off for the time being so that our internal team can study the matter. This will have no impact on on-campus printing.
