- Be a full-time enrolled, returning undergraduate sophomore, junior or senior
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above
- Be FAFSA ineligible
- Have completed an Institutional Need Assessment Form from the Office of Financial Aid

To Retain the Renewal Award:

- Commit and successfully participate in an identity-centered and academic success scholarship group with the Office of Multicultural Student Success
- Maintain a 2.5 GPA
