- 9. Copies of any experience letters
- 10. Names, date of birth and country of birth for spouse and children (if applicable)
- 11. Copy of I-94 card (front & back) and any other visa information for spouse and children.
- 12. Job title, detailed job description and current salary specifications.
- 13. Copy of latest paycheck
- 14. Copy of photo I.D.
- 15. Copy of W-2 forms for last available year.
