TRADITIONAL-STYLE HALLS Traditional halls close during winter break.	
BELDEN-RACINE HALL	This building houses residents in single-suite and double-suite rooms that share adjoining bathrooms. Belden-Racine Hall shares a courtyard with Munroe Hall that is open to all Lincoln Park Campus residents. Belden-Racine also offers converted housing, in which regular double residential units are converted to triple units.
CLIFTON-FULLERTON HALL	This building offers single-suite and double-suite rooms that share adjoining bathrooms. To accommodate more incoming freshmen in housing, a majority of the units in Clifton-Fullerton are considered converted housing, in which regular double residential units are converted to triple units.
CORCORAN HALL	This building houses residents in single- and double-occupancy rooms with community bathrooms located on each floor. Community bathrooms offer private shower stalls and are cleaned daily by professional staff. Individual rooms do not have air conditioning, but there is an air-conditioned lounge and music practice rooms on its first floor, and air-conditioned kitchen lounges on the second, third and fourth floors. Beds in Corcoran have lofting capabilities (up to 60").
MUNROE HALL	This building houses residents in single-suite and double-suite rooms that share adjoining bathrooms. Munroe Hall shares a courtyard with Belden-Racine Hall that is open to all Lincoln Park Campus residents. Beds in Munroe have lofting capabilities (up to 60"). Munroe also offers converted housing spaces in which regular double residential units are converted to triple units.
SETON HALL	This building offers double, triple and quad rooms with community bathrooms located on each floor. Community bathrooms offer private shower stalls and are cleaned daily by professional staff. Seton Hall has high ceilings and spacious walk-in closets. Beds in Seton have lofting capabilities (up to 60").
UNIVERSITY HALL	This building offers double-suite rooms with shared adjacent bathrooms. Bathroom entrances are located in an alcove just outside each room. University Hall offers double and triple rooms. Beds in University Hall have lofting capabilities (up to 60").
APARTMENT-STYLE HALLS Apartment-style halls remain open during winter break. Individual bedrooms are assigned in each unit.	
CENTENNIAL HALL	Centennial Hall apartments house four residents in a two-bedroom apartment or two residents in a studio apartment. Centennial Hall is home to a Whole Foods Market grocery store on its first two floors and university offices (Housing Services, Residential Education and Public Safety) on its third floor. Resident rooms are on floors four through six.
COURTSIDE APARTMENTS	Courtside Apartments is a Chicago greystone that has been converted into three student apartments each housing four residents. Units offer double- and single-occupancy bedrooms and access to an outdoor deck space overlooking the building's backyard. Each unit is equipped with a full kitchen, including a dishwasher, and all residents have access to a laundry room located in the basement. Beds in Courtside have lofting capabilities (up to 60").
McCABE HALL	This building offers one- and two-bedroom apartments housing two or four residents. McCabe Hall also offers efficiency apartments, which house four residents in a three-bedroom apartment and feature private bathrooms, living spaces and a kitchen area with a full refrigerator and microwave but no sink or stove. Community kitchens are available for residents of efficiency apartments. Apartments are not air-conditioned, but McCabe has an air-conditioned lounge, a technology lounge and a study room on the first floor.
SANCTUARY HALL	This historic building houses residents in a variety of apartment sizes that accomodate three to eight residents. Each apartment within Sanctuary Hall is unique, with various features such as exposed brick, spiral staircases and large picture windows.
SANCTUARY TOWNHOMES	Each townhome is a four-bedroom, three-and-one-half-bathroom unit that comfortably houses seven residents in three double bedrooms and one single bedroom. Sanctuary Townhomes feature private entrances off a gated courtyard, two full-sized refrigerators and an in-unit laundry room.

This building houses residents in two-, three- and four-person apartments. Sheffield Square also features

a beautiful gated courtyard. A basement-level laundry room is available for all residents.

SHEFFIELD SQUARE

All halls have the following furnishings: beds with mattresses; window treatments; dressers and/or built-in closet systems; desks and desk chairs; a recycle bin; a small trashcan; smoke detectors and fire sprinklers.
