This is a summary of the annual report of the DEPAUL UNIVERSITY HEALTH AND WELARE BENEFITS PLAN, EIN 36-2167048, Plan No. 520, for period 01/01/2023 through 12/31/2023. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

DEPAUL UNIVERSITY has committed itself to pay certain self-insured Medical, and Dental claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

#### **Insurance Information**

The plan has contracts with LINCOLN NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, HARTFORD LIFE AND ACCIDENT, VISION SERVICE PLAN, BLUECROSS BLUESHIELD OF ILLINOIS, COMPSYCH CORPORATION to pay Medical, Vision, Life Insurance, Long-term Disability, Accidental Death and Dismemberment, and Employee Assistance Program claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending 12/31/2023 were \$7,840,716.
