



## Evidence of Insurability

### Instructions for Online Submission

It's easy to submit evidence of insurability (EOI) online. Follow these simple steps:

1. Log in to:  
<https://campusconnect.depaul.edu>
2. Click Complete Evidence of Insurability / Statement of Health
3. Answer the questions asked
4. Electronically sign and submit
5. Save your confirmation report

Submitting EOI is an important step in applying for the right amount of life insurance to protect the future of your loved ones. It is a health questionnaire that helps us determine whether you and other dependent applicants qualify for new coverage or an increase in coverage. We make it easy to submit EOI online through <https://campusconnect.depaul.edu>:

- **Minimal questions** — the online questionnaire is reflexive to your responses, so you only have to answer questions that are relevant to you
- **Guided support** — embedded quick tips and search as you type feature help you provide quick and appropriate responses
- **Instant confirmation** — you'll receive email acknowledgment that we've received your application and in straightforward cases, you may be automatically approved

#### Get started now

1. Log in to <https://campusconnect.depaul.edu>  
Navigate to Self Service > Benefits > Liberty Mutual
2. Click Complete Evidence of Insurability / Statement of Health
3. Answer the questions asked about you and other applicants

Our online application is "smart," and asks only the questions that are relevant to you. Types of questions that you may be asked include:

- General applicant information — such as birthday, height, and weight
- Qualifying questions — including if you or other applicants have been diagnosed with a disease or are prescribed medications for a condition
- Medical questions — if you or other applicants have a condition, we may need to know a little more about it such as the name, diagnosis date, and treatments

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Save time! Collect the following information about each applicant before you get started:

- Date and place of birth
- Height and weight
- Employee ID
- Medical history (types and dates of conditions)
- Medications



4. Review your responses, then electronically sign and submit your application
5. Save your confirmation report

### What happens next?

In straightforward cases, you may be auto-approved for coverage. If not, we'll review your application and contact you if any additional information is required. In all cases we'll notify you of your application outcome.
