Who can join?	To join Blue Cross Group Medicare Advantage Open Access (PPO) , you must be enrolled in Part A and B, and be a retiree, or Medicare-eligible dependent of a retiree, of DePaul University.
	Our service area includes anywhere in the United States.
Which doctors, hospitals, and pharmacies can I use?	Blue Cross Group Medicare Advantage Open Access (PPO) has a network of doctors, hospitals, pharmacies, and other providers. You may seek care from any provider that accepts Medicare and agrees to bill us. Your benefit levels are the same whether or not you utilize a network provider.
	 You must generally use network pharmacies to fill your prescriptions for covered Part D drugs.

What do we cover?	Like all Medicare health plans, we cover everything that Original Medicare covers—and <i>more</i> .
	Our plan members get <i>all</i> of the benefits covered by Original Medicare. For some of these benefits, you may pay more in our plan than you would in Original Medicare. For others, you may pay less.
	Our plan members also get <i>more than what is</i> covered by Original Medicare. Some of the extra benefits are outlined in this booklet.
	We cover Part D drugs. In addition, we cover Part B drugs such as chemotherapy and some drugs administered by your provider.

	Call us and we will send you a copy of the formulary.
How will I determine my drug costs?	Our plan groups each medication into one of five "tiers." You will need to use your formulary to locate what tier your drug is on to determine how much it will cost you. The amount you pay depends on the drug's tier and what stage of the benefit you have reached. Later in this document we discuss the benefit stages that occur: Deductible, Initial Coverage, Coverage Gap, and Catastrophic Coverage.

Care*	Our plan covers up to 190 days in a lifetime for inpatient mental health care in a psychiatric hospital. The inpatient hospital care limit does not apply to inpatient mental services provided in a general hospital.
	The copays for hospital and skilled nursing facility (SNF) benefits are based on benefit periods. A benefit period begins the day you're admitted as an inpatient and ends when you haven't received any inpatient care (or skilled care in a SNF) for 60 days in a row. If you go into a hospital or a SNF after one benefit period has ended, a new benefit period begins.
