CAMPUSCONNECT.DEPAUL.EDU

Campus Connect is where you will register for classes, check your grades, and view your tuition account. Most computer systems at DePaul, including D2L and wifi, use your Campus Connect username and password. To reset your password, use the recover password link, call the Help Desk, or visit ID Card Services.

Desire2Learn (D2L)

D2L.DEPAUL.EDU

D2L is a course management system used by many professors at DePaul. D2L gives you online access to course documents, discussion boards, assignment submissions, an online grade book, quizzes, and more. Your class will only appear on D2L if your professor has activated the course.

Your DePaul ID card gives you access to computer labs, printers, library checkout, meal plans and more. ID Services offices are located at the Lincoln Park Student Center 109 and Loop DePaul Center 9200.

U-Pass

UPASS.DEPAUL.EDU

The Ventra U-Pass is a transit card which provides eligible students unlimited access to buses and trains on the Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) system. Your card will be reactivated each quarter that you are eligible. A replacement fee will be charged for lost cards.

Computer Labs

DePaul computer labs have computers and printers available for use throughout the Lincoln Park and Loop Campuses. Select labs are equipped with scanners, ADA equipment, and dual monitors.

Printing on Campus

The **Intelliprint** system is a network of printers located in all computer labs and residence halls. Color printers are available in the libraries and Daley 150.

As a student you receive a set amount of free print credits each quarter, which you can access with your DePaul ID Card. Add additional funds using your Demon Express account.

With the free **iPrint from Anywhere** software, you can print wirelessly from your laptop to the Intelliprint printers. Download the software from labdrive.

1. Go to LABDRIVE.DEPAUL.EDU
2. Navigate to **W:\software\Student**
3. Select either **Windows** or **Mac OS**
4. Select the **iPrint From Anywhere** folder and choose a package to download.

DePaul WiFi Connection

WIFI.DEPAUL.EDU

To connect:

1. Enable WiFi on your device and navigate to the listing of available WiFi networks.
2. Select **depaul**.
3. Under **DePaul Community WiFi**, select the type of device you are connecting: **Laptops** or **Mobile Devices**
4. Follow on screen instructions.

Some older devices may not be able to connect to the DePaul network. For information about connecting these devices, visit WIFI.DEPAUL.EDU/LEGACY

DePaul's WiFi network is part of the Eduroam network which allows the DePaul community to have wireless access when traveling to participating institutions.
