- ✓ **[Online Legal Document Check-In](#)**: Do this only after you arrive in the U.S. If you have trouble with the online check-in, please email ISS@depaul.edu for support. See "[check-in instructions PDF](#)" for more information.
- ✓ **[Immunization Records](#)**: We highly recommend that you get all your vaccines before arriving in the U.S. Plan to bring the original copy of your immunization records to keep with your immigration and other important documents. Please also review the most current [guidance on COVID-19](#) before you arrive.
- ✓ **[Update Your Address in Campus Connect](#)**: Before you attend orientation, please update your contact information. Don't forget to update your emergency contact information as well as your home and permanent addresses!

Why Update Your Information in Campus Connect?

Keeping your current contact information updated is a key component of maintaining your lawful F-1 or J-1 student status.

- Your professors and various academic departments and offices at DePaul University need your current contact information to send you critical correspondence.
- ***Failure to regularly update your address information in Campus Connect could result in a loss of your legal F-1 or J-1 non-immigrant status.***
