THIS WEEK: HOW TO REGISTER FOR CLASSES

Register for Classes: We hope you are excited to register for classes! If you are a first-year undergraduate student, then you will be able to register for classes after you meet with an academic advisor at orientation. For now, you can look at the course catalog and think about what you want to take.

How Many Classes Do You Have To Take? As an international student, U.S. law requires you to be enrolled in a “full course of study”. How many courses you need to take will depend on your level of study. Click on: [How many classes do I have to take?](#)

DEPAUL HAS A QUARTER SYSTEM & A SEMESTER SYSTEM

DePaul's academic calendar (schedule) probably looks different from what you have in your home country. DePaul operates on a [quarter system](#), which means classes only meet for 10 weeks. In that time, you start a new course, read material, write papers, and take exams! The only exception to the quarter system is the College of Law which uses a [semester system](#) and meets for 16 weeks.

Typically, the quarter calendar looks like this:

- Fall: September – November
- Winter: January – March

- Spring: April – June
- Summer: June – August
