# NEXT STEPS

## Student Portals

DePaul students use two web portals to conduct business: Blue Demon Domain and Campus Connect.

### BLUE DEMON DOMAIN

Blue Demon Domain is the application and next steps portal. You may have set up an account when you were applying to DePaul to check on the status of your application and view your checklist. If you haven't logged in yet, visit [go.depaul.edu/bluedemondomain](http://go.depaul.edu/bluedemondomain) and set up your account. ### CAMPUS CONNECT

You recently received a two-part email with instructions on setting up your Campus Connect account. You will be required to use these Campus Connect login credentials to move through some of your next steps. Once you are enrolled at DePaul, you will use this portal for all university transactions and administrative tasks.

**Please note: Your Campus Connect login credentials can be used for both portals**

## Intent to Enroll

To reserve your spot in the freshman class, you must submit your intent to enroll and non-refundable tuition deposit by May 1, 2019 (students admitted after May 1 are encouraged to submit their intent to enroll within two weeks of receiving their acceptance packets).

## Required Tuition Deposit

A tuition deposit is required to confirm your intention to enroll. A \$200 non-refundable deposit should be submitted by May 1, 2019, or if you are admitted after that date, no later than two weeks from receipt of your acceptance packet.

Your deposit will be credited to your student account and will be deducted from your bill after you register for classes. This deposit will apply only for fall 2019 enrollment.

## Housing Agreement and Prepayment

DePaul offers many on-campus living arrangements for incoming freshmen. Please see the enclosed "Rooms 101" book for housing options, rates and instructions on how to access the online housing agreement.

New incoming freshmen will be guaranteed housing if they submit and complete a housing agreement no later than May 1 (June 1 for transfers). Campus, building, room type and roommate preferences are not guaranteed.

You should submit your legally binding housing agreement (including parent/guardian voucher) and the \$400 prepayment as soon as you have confirmed you will be attending DePaul and have determined you want to live on campus. Once both are received, the Department of Housing will notify you of your housing status.

If you are confirmed for housing and decide not to enroll at DePaul or decide to live off campus, you must submit your housing cancellation in writing by May 1, 2019, to be refunded your prepayment. To submit a cancellation, visit [go.depaul.edu/housingcancellation](http://go.depaul.edu/housingcancellation) and follow the prompts. If you cancel after May 1, 2019, a cancellation fee will apply. Consult Section 4 of your Housing Agreement Terms and Conditions for applicable cancellation policies.

## Financing Your Education

### FEDERAL, STATE AND NEED-BASED INSTITUTIONAL FINANCIAL AID

DePaul encourages all families to file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) in order to be considered for federal grants and loans, state aid programs, and institutional need-based financial aid.

To be considered for a financial aid award, complete the FAFSA at [fafsa.gov](https://fafsa.gov) as soon as possible beginning October 1, 2018; our priority deadline is November 15, 2018.

You can access the online form at [fafsa.gov](https://fafsa.gov). Use the school finder on the FAFSA website and select DePaul (001671) as one of the schools to which you would like your FAFSA information sent.

### SCHOLARSHIPS

All students who apply to DePaul are automatically considered for academic scholarships upon admission to the fall quarter. If you have been selected for a scholarship, you will find an enclosed letter outlining your scholarship award and the process for renewing the scholarship. You must enroll at DePaul in order to receive your scholarship award.

## Placement Process for Entering Students

At DePaul, students complete the required placement process for writing and mathematics online before registering for orientation.

## Orientation: Premiere DePaul

In the spring, you will receive registration materials for Premiere DePaul, DePaul's mandatory freshman orientation program. During Premiere DePaul, you will meet your future classmates, get acquainted with the university's history and campus, meet with an academic advisor and register for classes. There are several Premiere DePaul programs scheduled throughout the summer. After reviewing the orientation information and completing your placement process, please register as soon as possible for the program date that is most convenient for you at Blue Demon Domain.

## Final High School Transcript

As stated in your admit letter, enrollment is contingent upon satisfactory academic performance through all terms of your high school career.

Please send us your final high school transcript as soon as it is available. If you should fall below the academic standards on which your admission was based or exhibit a significant change in character, DePaul has the right to revoke your offer of admission, withdraw you from any courses for which you have registered and institute additional requirements for reapplication.

Failure to submit your final transcript could prevent you from registering for classes.

## Transferring Credit

### ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP), INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB) AND COLLEGE-LEVEL EXAMINATION PROGRAM (CLEP)

DePaul recognizes the achievements of our students as represented by their completion of exams through the AP, IB and CLEP programs. Students may earn credit applicable toward their general education, major field or elective requirements.

All AP, IB and CLEP scores/transcripts should be mailed to DePaul University, Office of Admission, 1 E. Jackson Blvd., Chicago, IL 60604 or sent electronically by the testing agency. ### COLLEGE CREDIT

If you have taken college courses while in high school, the credit may be transferable to DePaul. Please have your official college transcript(s) sent to the Office of Admission.

## Immunization Forms

Illinois state law requires that all enrolled students submit proof of their immunization history. Although DePaul allows students to bring cars to campus, and parking permits are available for purchase from Parking Services, most students find it easier to rely on public transportation. Every full-time undergraduate DePaul student is eligible for the CTA Ventra U-Pass, a public transit pass that allows students unlimited use of CTA trains and buses during the academic year. The U-Pass is provided each quarter for a nominal fee (included in student fees).
