Turkey's House of Mary (Meryem Ana Evi), a popular shrine visited by Muslims and Christians alike, would not exist without the efforts of two Vincentians: Sr. Marie de Mandat-Grancey, a Daughter of Charity working in Izmir, Turkey, who "discovered" and renovated the shrine, and Archbishop Joseph Descuffi, C.M. of Izmir, who promoted the shrine in the 1950s, and whose impassioned speech about shared Christian-Muslim devotion at the shrine helped to influence the development of *Nostra Aetate 3* at Vatican II.
