DUTY TO REGISTER. READ THE FOLLOWING TO THE OFFENDER and OFFENDER MUST INITIAL EACH

Completion of this form does not constitute an annual or quarterly registration. You must register, in person, with the law enforcement agency of jurisdiction in which you reside.

You must, within 3 days of beginning employment at an Institution of Higher Education, notify in person the agency of jurisdiction in which you reside, the agency of jurisdiction in which you are employed by an Institution of Higher Education and the public safety or security director of the Institution of Higher Education,

You must, within 3 days of enrolling at an Institution of Higher Education, notify in person the agency of jurisdiction in which you reside, the agency of jurisdiction in which you are attending an Institution of Higher Education, and the public safety or security director of the Institution of Higher Education.

You must, within 3 days of changing your employment and/or changing your status in enrollment at an Institution of Higher Education, (commencement, termination, and any and all changes), notify in person the agency of jurisdiction in which you reside, the agency of jurisdiction in which you are working at or attending an Institution of Higher Education and the public safety or security director of the Institution of Higher Education.

An out-of-state student and/or out-of-state employee residing in another state but attending and/or employed at an Institution of Higher Education must, within 3 days of beginning school or employment, register with the agency of jurisdiction in which you are enrolled/employed and the public safety or security director of the Institution of Higher Education.

You must renew your employment or student enrollment registration, in person, with the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction of your residence, the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the Institution of Higher Education, and the public safety or security director of the institution of Higher Education within one year from the date of your most recent registration until you complete your registration requirement.

Failure to comply with the provisions of the Illinois Sex Offender Registration Act is a Class 3 felony.
