The Environmental Health & Safety Office, in consultation with other affected departments, ensures compliance with federal and state regulations relating to chemical hygiene; the inventory of chemicals; compilation of safety data sheets (SDSs); the proper storage of chemicals; the disposal of hazardous waste and the provision of safety training and "right-to-know" information for employees and students working with or around chemicals.
