Undergraduate Probation Policy

Policy Summary

Undergraduate students who fail to maintain a 2.00 (C) cumulative grade point average are automatically placed on academic probation.

Scope

This policy affects the following groups of the University:

- Full-Time Faculty
- Part-Time Faculty
- Students

This policy affects all members of the above groups.

Policy

Any undergraduate student who fails to maintain a 2.00 (C) cumulative grade point average is on academic probation. A student is removed from academic probation when the cumulative grade point average reaches the required minimum of 2.00 (C). Ordinarily the student will not be permitted to be on academic probation for longer than two consecutive quarters. Academic disciplinary action will be taken by the dean of the student's home college or school in accordance with the degree of the student's academic deficiency.

Procedures

At the conclusion of the grading period, a system process is run to attach probation status to undergraduate students whose grade point average is below 2.000. Levels of probation are based on the number of consecutive terms that the grade point average remains below 2.000.

College offices advise students as to measures to overcome the deficit.
