RECOGNITIONS

LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

At DePaul University, we acknowledge that we live and work on traditional Native lands that are today home to representatives of well over 100 different tribal nations. We extend our respect to all of them, including the Potawatomi, Ojibwe, and Odawa nations, who signed the Treaty of Chicago in 1821 and 1833. We also recognize the Ho-Chunk, Myaamia, Menominee, Illinois Confederacy, and Peoria people who also maintained relationships with this land.

We acknowledge that these sacred homelands were ruptured by the European invasion of the Americas. In 1493, Pope Alexander VI promulgated the Doctrine of Discovery, which seized Native lands and resources with impunity.

This doctrine has been used by countries throughout the Americas, including the U.S., to legitimize colonial policies of displacement and genocide toward Native peoples and to justify colonial legacies of white superiority and global capitalism.

We appreciate that today Chicago is home to one of the largest urban

Native population in the United States. We further recognize and support the
enduring presence of Native peoples among our faculty, staff, and student body.

And in the spirit of St. Vincent de Paul, we reaffirm our commitment,
both as an institution and as individuals, to help make our community
and our society a more equitable, welcoming,
and just place for all.

Nezih Altay
PROFESSOR OF MANAGEMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP
Driehaus College of Business

Dr. Nezih Altay's service-centered research examines the procurement, storage, and movement of disaster relief aid. He has created innovative and Vincentian-focused curriculum and student programs, including his work as advisor for the student Supply

Chain Management Society and founding director of the Supply Chain graduate program. Dr. Altay plans the annual Chicagoland Supply Chain Forum Conference and continually serves a broad range of leadership roles within the university. In the community, Dr. Altay serves as a volunteer lecturer for the American Red Cross and as the Technical Advisor for Field Ready, a humanitarian NGO working in the innovation space. His internal and external grant funded research has received national awards, impressive scholarly citation, and is foundational to the field of Humanitarian Supply Chain Management.



Wendy Epstein
PROFESSOR OF LAW
College of Law

Dr. Wendy Epstein is a prolific scholar in the area of healthcare law. Dr. Epstein is also the principal investigator on a \$400,000 grant from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation focused on increasing access to health insurance and care. She received the College

of Law and the University Excellence in Teaching Awards in 2017 and the Spirit of Inquiry Award in 2019. She was also named a Public Voices Fellow through The OpEd Project in 2020. Dr. Epstein engages in significant service in the Law School and at the University. She is the Faculty Director of the Master of Jurisprudence in Health Law and Healthcare Compliance and for the Certificate in Health Law. She currently chairs the Faculty Programs Committee and the Health Law Committee and spearheaded the Jaharis Faculty Fellows program. Dr. Epstein also currently serves on the Consortium for Health Initiatives at DePaul. In 2024, she was appointed by Governor Pritzker to the Illinois Health Benefits Exchange Advisory Committee.



Li Jin
PROFESSOR OF CHINESE STUDIES
College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences

Dr. Li Jin's research has been internally and externally funded, most notably through her work with DePaul's Social Transformation Research Collaborative, funded by a nearly \$2 million Mellon Foundation Grant. She has served as the founder and leader of

the DePaul-China Alliance Affinity Group and a member of the task force to help DePaul apply for the Asian American Native American Pacific Islander Serving Institution grant. Dr. Jin has led the Chinese Language, Chinese Studies, and Global Asian Studies programs. In her department, she advises graduate research projects and serves on dissertation committees. Her teaching has earned her the Excellence in Teaching Award and the LAS Suchar Innovation and Development Award. Dr. Jin's integration of research, teaching, and service through an interdisciplinary approach to Chinese thought, art, and history models Vincentian values and a steadfast commitment to addressing the needs of contemporary society.
