- Finished second in the Inside Higher Ed Academic National Tournament

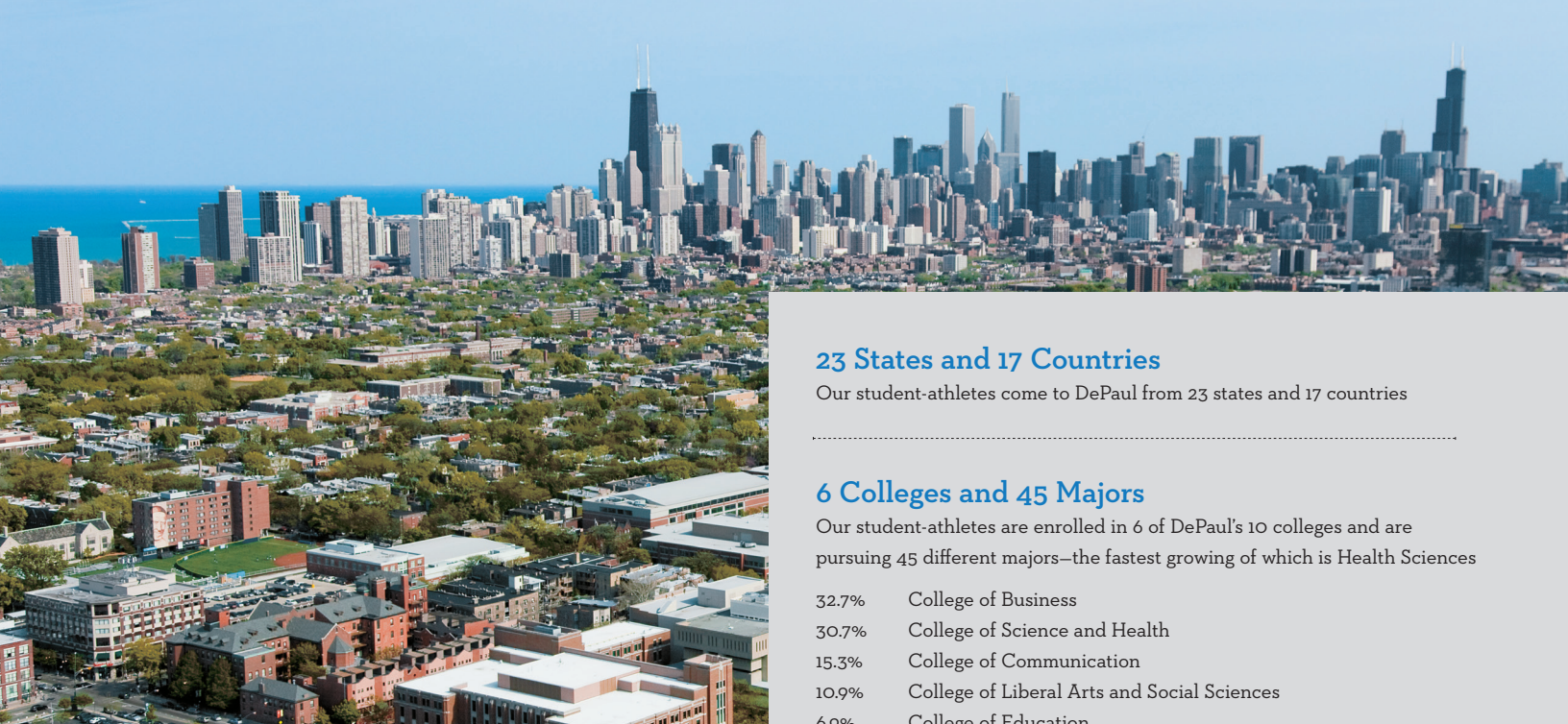

Over 79% of our student-athletes earned a 3.0 or greater each quarter and were named to the DePaul University Athletic Director's Honor Roll (80.7% in fall and 79.2% in winter).

Over 54% of our student-athletes earned a 3.5 or greater each quarter and were named to the DePaul University Dean's List (58.4% in fall and 54.5% in winter).

13%

Over 13% of our student-athletes earned a perfect 4.0 each quarter (17.3% in fall and 13.9% in winter).

Our Athletic Department GPA was over a 3.4 each quarter (3.441 in fall and 3.409 in winter).
