Dear Colleagues,

Happy New Year! Athletic Academic Advising and the Department of Athletics are proud to share our Blue Ribbon Newsletter. This annual publication highlights the academic achievements of DePaul student-athletes during the 2016-2017 academic year.

Detailed in this newsletter are the numerous academic accolades received by our DePaul student-athletes last year including:

The program as a whole recorded a 3.453 GPA.

Eight of fifteen teams earned the highest GPA in the BIG EAST Conference.

83.2% of our student-athletes were named to the 2016-2017 BIG EAST All-Academic Team.

2017-2018 is off to a great start as well, in the Fall Quarter:

169 student-athletes (81.3%) earned over a 3.0. 124 student-athletes (59.6%) earned over a 3.5. 34 student-athletes (16.3%) earned a 4.0.

We are very proud of these accomplishments and know that many of you play an important role in the academic success of our student-athletes. Student-athletes work hard to balance the rigors of academics and the demands of their sport. The assistance they receive from faculty and staff on campus is greatly appreciated and we wish to thank you for your tremendous support.

To celebrate these accomplishments, we ask that you join us in honoring our BIG EAST All-Academic Team at our annual halftime ceremony during the men's basketball game versus Creighton on February 7th at 8 p.m. The game will be at the beautiful new Wintrust Arena and the first 125 faculty or staff who use code "AAANIGHT" to purchase their game tickets will receive a "Playing Possessed" shirt at halftime of the game.
