DePaul found SAE in violation of the following sections of the Code of Student Responsibility: (1) Alcohol; (2) Hazing; and (3) Disorderly, Violent, Intimidating, or Dangerous Behavior.	SAE was suspended through July 30, 2029. Prior to returning and recruiting new members, SAE must participate in an educational meeting regarding hazing prevention and complete process requirements to re-register as an organization based on policy and procedure active at the point they are eligible to return.
