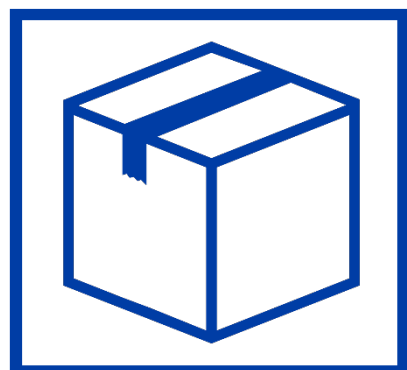

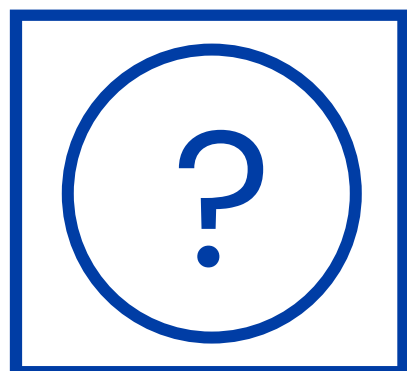

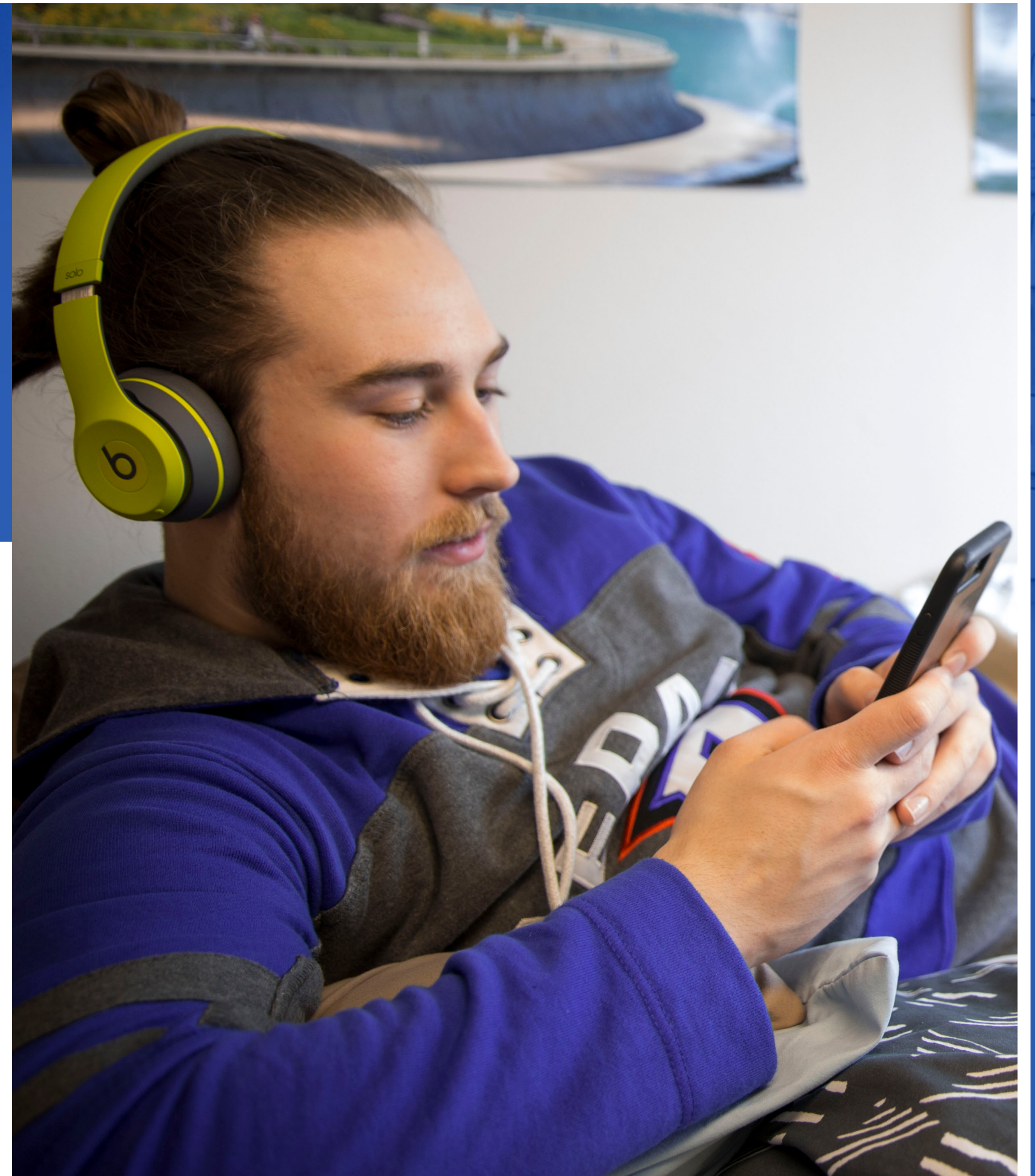

Move-In

PREPARE TO LIVE ON CAMPUS!

- Move-In webpage: go.depaul.edu/movein
- Schedule move-in appointment based on orientation date and Discover/Explore classes. Most students will pick from:
 - Wednesday, August 26 (for Premiere 14 & 15)
 - Sunday, August 30 (for Premiere 1-13 & Discover)
 - Saturday, September 5 (for Premiere 1-13 & Explore)
- Connect with roommate(s) beforehand.
- Complete online process for a Blue Demon Card (DePaul ID card) no later than August 15.

Quick & Easy Steps For Move-In

1

Arrive at your residence hall at your move-in appointment time.

2

Check-in with Housing staff to receive your welcome packet.

3

Unload your vehicle, then park in the garage.

4

Borrow a moving cart to transport belongings to your unit.

Meal Swipes

- For all-you-care-to-eat spaces (dining hall)
- Distributed on Sundays (LP) and Mondays (UC)
- Do not rollover quarter-to-quarter and are unavailable during breaks



Blue Bucks (LP) / Flex Dollars (UC)

- Use at cafes, quick service restaurants, and convenience stores on campus
- Distributed at the beginning of each quarter
- Rollover each quarter until end of spring



Meal plans are either tied to a Blue Demon Card for LP residents or University Center ID card for UC residents.
