

Instructions on how to access the Modern Language Placement Tests

Online Placement Process

Students must complete their required placement exams at least 10 days prior to their intended orientation date to allow for exam processing and orientation registration processing. Placements are used as a guide for advisors to help students select the appropriate level coursework and should be completed to the best of your ability.

The placement process site must only be accessed by the student named above and the placement process must be completed only by the student. Access to the placement process site by anyone other than the student is considered a violation of DePaul's academic integrity policy by the student. If you are not the student, please close this page immediately and do not access this site again.

Math Test

Once you click the test link, you will be taken to Desire 2 Learn (D2L). If the window does not open go to <https://d2l.depaul.edu>. You will also receive an email with instructions on accessing the test. You must take all five sections of the test before you are able to register for Orientation, so please plan accordingly. Your advisor will use the results of your math placement test to determine which math course you are prepared to take. It is important that you complete the final placement test in a setting that allows you to focus. You must allow enough time to complete all sections of the test in one sitting.

Writing Placement

This is a self-paced questionnaire. The information you provide in the writing placement process will help you decide which writing course is appropriate for you.

Please complete a modern language placement test if you plan to participate in a modern language course at DePaul. To be granted access to a modern language test, click on the button below. You will be sent an email that will give you [directions](#) for accessing the test. You should take the test within 60 days. If you do not complete within 60 days contact SRSupport@depaul.edu. Students wishing to study a language of which they have no prior knowledge are not required to take the modern language test and will start in the introductory course. Introduction

DePaul University Placement Test - Spanish


This test is designed to measure your ability to understand spoken Spanish. It is intended to help place you in the appropriate level of instruction in Spanish courses.

Time: You will have up to 2 hours to complete the test. Any questions answered or saved after the time has expired will not be counted. Your time will begin when you click "Start Quiz".

Navigation and General Instructions: Navigation backward in this test is not allowed. You have only one attempt at answering each question. Some of the pages in this test contain more than one item per page. In these cases all the questions on the page relate to the audio file or paragraph at the top of the page.

On pages with audio files the questions all relate to the audio. You will hear several short passages. Some will be monologues and some will be dialogues with 2 or more persons. You will hear each passage only once. The audio contains pauses to allow you to answer the questions for each passage. Feel free to look ahead to the questions for a passage so that you get a general idea about its story line and content. Listen to the entire passage before answering any of the questions. Do not try to remember everything; rather try to understand the passage in a global or general sense. Select the best answer from the choices given. There is no penalty for guessing, so feel free to make an educated guess in order to answer as many questions as possible. It is not expected that everyone will be able to answer all questions, but everyone should be able to answer some questions on each passage.

Results: Your results will be recorded and sent to your advisor. Your advisor will discuss these with you at orientation during your advising session.
